

General Rules of Becks Lake Fish Camp

- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED TO BE CONSUMED ON PROPERTY.
- NO LITTERING. Please use the trash cans to help keep the area's clean.
- NO SWIMMING allowed anywhere on the Property. There be gators and giant turtles!
- NO WEAPONS ALLOWED (Except for Licensed Hunters Launching or Retrieving boats in the Launch area.
- GOOD BEHAVIOR ONLY - ENFORCED BY DEPUTY SHERIFF
- DON'T MOLEST THE WILDLIFE - Please do not harm wild plants or animals. Feeding of wildlife is strictly prohibited. Be advised that this is an area teeming with wildlife of many species including snakes. *You're in Nature!*
- Please do not damage or remove any park facilities, including picnic tables and park signs.
- Pets are allowed but must be under physical control at all times on a leash no more than eight feet long. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- Guests must pay according to the posted fees and put the tear-off flap on their dashboard. Failure to do so may result in your vehicle being towed or revocation of use of this area.
- Guests who have paid to fish should drive to the "Fishing Point" parking area, from which it's a short walk to the point.
- Boat Launch and Fishing Point users are subject to the Rules that are posted in those areas.
- Only Guests with a camping or activity permit are allowed in the Group Camp

area or connecting trails.

- Please respect and obey all signs and restricted areas.

Becks Lake Fish Camp is a Nature Park. Treat it with respect and courtesy.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE RULES POSTED AT THE BOAT LAUNCH, FISHING POINT and any other AREAS on the property.

Use of Becks Lake Fish Camp signifies your acceptance of all posted rules and your agreement to use it solely at your own risk.
